- Reading for general understanding, for detail, scanning for key information and reading for main ideas.
- Recognise and write the numbers 0-10
 - Use capital letters and full stops in sentences.
- Read and understand information on contact cards - phone number, email address, etc.
- Write about nationality and jobs, I'm a student. I'm from Qatar.
- Write about your friend and about your family.

New Language

- Basic classroom instructions - Look, read, listen, write, point, say.
 - Singular and plural, e.g. a taxi - two taxis
 - Day and time, e.g. morning, evening, 8:00 am, 2:00 pm
 - Numbers 11 - 100
- Grammar: Possessive adjectives, e.g. his, her, our, their books and verb be, e.g. he is, they are, she isn't, etc.
- Members of the family, e.g. mother, father, sister, etc.
